Fraser Island, the world's largest sand island, has officially been renamed to its traditional name K'gari (pronounced *GAR-ree*). The paradise island, off the coast of Queensland, Australia, is a popular tourist spot. It is also the home of the Butchulla, the indigenous Australians who have made the island their 1. \_\_\_\_\_ for about 60,000 to 70,000 years.

K'gari is quite distinctive. It has no roads, around 100 freshwater lakes, and the phenomenon of having the world's only rainforest on sand.

The campaign to have the island renamed has taken many years, but in 2021 the idea was embraced more seriously by the Australian government.
